The 2008-2010 Clinical Training is for practitioners who wish to incorporate the treatment of pre- and perinatal (PPN) trauma and shock into their practices, and for babies, children, and adults who wish to be clients. The first module welcomes newcomers who complete at-home prerequisite courses (no exceptions), and old-timers who wish to expand and deepen their skills in treatment. Participants may come for experiential work only, not to learn techniques, and will be designated clients. All locations to be announced.

MODULE I - CONTENT

- Teaches students to use intuitive techniques to assess their own shock and trauma levels
- Describes the seven basic impacts of shock in Birth Stages 1 & 2
- Demonstrates cranial and simulation holds for the stages and provides practice with other students
- Instructs students to direct and move energy within their own bodies for self-healing.

MODULE II - CONTENT

- Extends the learning of Module I
- Teaches students to extend themselves to others in simple, graduated, and sequenced energy steps, to assess and treat trauma
- Describes the seven basic impacts of shock in Birth Stages 3 and 4
- Teaches cranial and simulation holds and provides practice in healing others

Module III and IV Course Outlines will be handed out during Module I. If interested, you can order a six-page description of Modules I - IV, along with a list of handouts, presentations, and required reading.

Tuition per Module: \$900 (does not include meals and lodging). Each Module requires a \$300 deposit, refundable for medical or personal emergencies. Missed modules must be paid for in full, and completed by home study, materials provided by ES. Refunds are minus a processing fee of 50%. Deposits for Modules are processed as they are received. Students are encouraged to share lodging and bring lunches to save on expenses. Local trainees may provide housing.
